



This is an increase of 17 organisations in 7 months, since the last statistics in September 2001.


This indicates a growth of 4.5% in organizations during this period.








Non-Sectarian Buddhist Organisations and Groups in Australia PIE CHART BREAKDOWN




Statistical History of the number of Buddhist Traditions in Australia from July 1995 to April 2002

The Buddhist traditions as represented by their respective organizations have increased in number by 211 (126.0%) in 6 years and 9 months, in the period from June 1995 to April 2002.

The Mahayana form the largest representation of Buddhism in Australia with 36.5 % of the National Total of 378 Buddhist organizations, followed by the Vajrayana at 24.5%, the Theravada at 24.0%, and the Non-Sectarian 15.0%
